


Via Lucis ~ The Stations of the Resurrection

Via Lucis, literally translated the Way of the Light, is a beautiful devotion brought back into the hearts and lives of Catholics around the world by Blessed Pope John Paul II. Popularly known as the Stations of the Resurrection, *Via Lucis* follows the same format as the Stations of the Cross. The *Via Lucis* includes fourteen stations for reflection and meditation suited for the Easter season. These stations depict Jesus' resurrection, all his resurrected appearances, and concludes with his sending of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.
